At Family Support Network we realize that having a baby in the NICU is difficult for families. It can be stressful for brothers and sisters. FSN wants to help them too!



The Sibling Orientation Program is appropriate for ages 2 and up.

There is no fee for the program.

We recommend that you schedule your session early in your baby's stay.

Children will do some of these activities:

- Talk about why babies are in the NICU
- Hear how to keep germs away from babies
- Take a guided tour of the NICU
- Make a calendar to "count up" to discharge day
- Participate in medical play.
- See our library collection just for brother and sisters.
- Receive a copy of "No Bigger Than My Teddy Bear"
- Take home a comfort blanket provided by Project Linus
